Dombroski stated that Harrisonville used to be R3 which is why the district requirements are so similar. Finkel asked McGreevy if there were just plants around the new building. McGreevy stated yes, and that there is a fence around the entire housing project. Myers stated that on plan sheet G0.0 there is a statement saying that the building meets all standards but the percentages are not listed on the sheet. Myers stated the requirements are met but they need to be on plan sheet G0.0.
